Cemeteries Maintained by the Archdiocese

The five cemeteries maintained by the Archdiocese total an area of 65 acres. The grass mowing effort alone requires 6-8 men working continuously six days per week from

May to September. We repair approximately 1,000 plots each year with topsoil and new sods. There are several kilometers of paved and gravel lanes, buildings, fences, equipment etc. which all require regular maintenance. By far the biggest challenge is the removal of broken and/or torn artificial flowers, glass, plastic flower pots, solar lights etc. all of which create safety hazards. Needless to say, maintaining the cemeteries is an extensive and expensive effort. We rely heavily on the support of our parishioners and families to maintain our cemeteries to a level of care appropriate to the dignity and sanctity deserving of the final resting place of our loved ones. We thank all those for their past support through annual collections and other donations and look forward to their future support.
